“JOHN RUSKIN, HENRY JAMES and THE SHROPSHIRE LADS”

A journey through Shropshire's "beautiful little places" and further afield in the company of John Ruskin and Henry James and their Shropshire friends and contemporaries who were eminent during the Victorian era.

Cynthia Gamble who was born and raised in Shropshire now lives and works in London. Her local knowledge and her scholarship in the works of Ruskin and other Victorian writers is evident in her latest book the subject of this lecture. A leading authority on Ruskin she is Visiting Fellow of the Ruskin Centre at Lancaster University and Vice Chairman of the Ruskin Society. A former teacher of French at University level she is much in demand as a lecturer in Britain and throughout Western Europe.
